- ¹ It is good to give thanks to the LORD,
to sing praises to the Most High.
- ² It is good to proclaim your unfailing love in the morning,
your faithfulness in the evening,
- ³ accompanied by a ten-stringed instrument, a harp,
and the melody of a lyre.
- ⁴ You thrill me, LORD, with all you have done for me!
I sing for joy because of what you have done.
- ¹² But the godly will flourish like palm trees
and grow strong like the cedars of Lebanon.
- ¹³ For they are transplanted to the LORD's own house.
They flourish in the courts of our God.
